WINNERS AND X1 BEST RUNNER UP TO PROGRESS TO SF

RULES

1. Tournament Format:-

There are 4 pairs in each division of this tournament. In the groups each pair will play each other once, the best of three sets, tie breaks in the first two sets if necessary.

2. Points System:-

A point will be awarded for each set won (Results 2-0 or 2-1). The 3 group winners will go into the Semi finals along with the best runner up. In the event of a tie for group winner the result of the tie between two pairs shall decide the winners. If there is a three way tie the results involving just those teams will decide the outcome. The best runner up shall be the team with 1st/most sets won 2/best set difference 3/coin toss

3. Rearranging Fixtures/Substitutes.

All fixtures will be arranged for Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday, The onus is totally on you to contact both your partner and your opponents to rearrange any fixture and to ensure a court is available and booked. No fixtures are to be rearranged with less than 48 hours notice and a walkover given or a substitute used instead unless the pair who can make the fixture expressly agree to a rescheduling. In the case of a substitute being obtained, it is the responsibility of the party who cannot play to do the organizing and to ensure the sub is of an equal or lesser standard/line. If in doubt consult the tournament referee. In addition only one member of a pair may be substituted in any one match. In the semi finals and final substitutes must be pre-approved by the tournament referee and will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances. All finals must be played on an agreed finals night. If in doubt phone Frank 087 2904472. If a substitute is not obtained then the game is forfeited and the unavailable player should inform the other three players involved by 6pm on the day of the game. Any player failing to show up for a game will in the first instance receive a warning and on subsequent infringements face disciplinary action. Under no circumstances should matches be replayed when one party fails to turn up unless expressly approved by the tournament referee in light of exceptional circumstances.

Any rearrangement of fixtures should be noted on the Fixture sheet in the clubhouse. This will allow others to note the freeing up of a court, Monday to Thursday, which then can be booked by others rearranging their fixtures. **All rearranged matches must be completed by the weekend following** unless other arrangements have been pre approved by the tournament referee.

We are drawing up the fixtures such that one court is free every night for re-arranging fixtures, friendlies (7pm or 8.30pm only). These courts will also be available to people not playing in the tournament to book and must be pre booked or can be used on a first come basis, tournament match or not.

4. Trophies & Presentation Function:-

The Final will all be played on a date to be arranged.

5. Entry Fee, Lights and Balls:-

There will be an entry fee of €5 for this tournament . Head Tennis balls are available from committee members at €5 for 3 balls. Lights are provided, key in cupboard. Please turn off your lights after the match is completed.
